Matthew 21:9 NIV "The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

Imagine that your favorite person was coming to visit you. Someone who was super important. The coolest person ever. What would you do? How would you get prepared? How would you react? Would you clean everything? Would you make something special to eat?

That's kind of how the people felt when they found out Jesus was going to be in Jerusalem. You can find this story in Matthew 21. Jesus told 2 of his disciples to get him a donkey and he made his way down the city. People were praising him and putting their robes and palms as he passed by. They shouted "Hosanna!" which means "save us."

They knew at that point that Jesus was really the son of God. He was fulfilling a prophecy. This king of Israel would be unlike any other. He would come to save the world.

This is what Palm Sunday is all about. Celebrating our amazing king. Let's make Jesus an important part of our lives. Let's make him the king of our heart. Let's worship him!

Here are some ideas to help think about it during the week:

- Make a palm tree craft with your family or a couple of friends to help you remember
- Read Matthew 21:1-11 as a family
- Play a worship song and sing it as loud as you can

**Talk about it:** Why were the people so excited that Jesus was coming? How would you react if Jesus was visiting you? What can you do to better make Jesus the most important part of your life?

# The Donkey and the King

The triumphal entry Matthew 21:1-11; John 12:16-19; Luke 19:36-40



Challenge your child to retell the story. Help him or her remember key details by asking the following questions:

- **What did Jesus tell two of His disciples to find?** (a donkey) **→**
- why did people put cloaks and palm branches on the road before Jesus? (to honor Him)
- ★ What did Jesus say would happen even if the people stopped shouting? (the stones would still praise Him)

Read the following thought aloud to help increase your child's understanding:

Jesus is the King that God promised would come. When Jesus rode in on the donkey, He was showing the people who He was. They honored Him, shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is the King of Israel!"



Together, discover how this specific lesson ties into God's Big Story. Read the following aloud to your child:

Where Jesus is, God is. Jesus brings God's power. He fulfilled promises that God had made to His people, too. This proves that Jesus is the King of Israel, the promised Savior!



"Tell (cup hands around your mouth) the people of Jerusalem,

'Look (place hand over your brow and look around),

your King (pretend to place a crown on your head) is coming to you. He is humble (fold hands together on chest and bow your head),

riding on a donkey—riding on a donkey's colt (pretend to hold a rope with both hands)."

Matthew 21:5 (NLT)
